

Practice Match Regulations and Procedures

August 2006

Practice matches are excellent opportunities for our junior members to play at a special discounted rate (\$20/hr.).

Members Only: A member and guest are **not** entitled to practice matches. They may, however, use Junior Walk-On Time (JWOT)

Time Limit: A practice match may not last more than 1-1/2 hrs. The normal length is 1 hour.

Restricted Hours: A practice match may be scheduled before 4:30 p.m. on weekdays, Sunday between 6:00-7:00 p.m., or Saturday after 2:00 p.m. if there is not a travel team match scheduled. Check with the desk receptionist to determine if you are eligible for practice match rate.

Designating a Practice Match: Players should identify themselves as practice match participants when checking in to play.

Report Scores: Players should report all practice match results at the control desk.

Junior Walk-On Time

JWOT is a special offer to junior members that entitles them to a discounted court rate for playing on an unreserved court.

When? Any time until the club closes. The club will not remain open for juniors to walk on if no other courts are scheduled.

How much? \$20/hour

Who? JWOT is available only to junior members **playing with other junior members or nonmember juniors.**

How Long? JWOT is unlimited unless other juniors desire to walk onto that court. If this should occur, a one hour limit is enforced.

Juniors may call ahead to see if courts are available for JWOT.

Parent-Child Time

Who? Any club member may bring a parent (member or nonmember) and play a maximum of 1 ½ hrs at \$20/hr. These visits are not considered guest visits.

When? Saturdays 6:00-9:00 p.m. and Sunday 8:00-9:00 a.m. and 6:00-9:00 p.m.

How much? \$20/hr with a maximum of 1 ½ hrs/day. Parent-Child Time when used as a Junior Excellence Make-up is \$10/hr.

To ensure proper billing, the member must inform the control desk of the desire to use Parent-Child Time and if the PCT is intended as a make-up for Junior Excellence.

Junior Excellence Make-Ups

Make up options for Junior Excellence members:

Student may **attend a meeting of the same group** on a different day.

Student may **attend a Junior Excellence Make-up day**. See brochure for dates.

Student may **attend a meeting of a lower group**.

Student may use the **ball machine for one hour** at no charge.

Student may play during **Parent-Child hours on Saturday or Sunday (see above times) for a reduced rate of \$10/hour**.

No matter which option is chosen, the make-up must occur during the same session in which the absence occurred.

Student must declare to the professional taking attendance or the desk staff that he/she is doing a make-up.
